If a first aider is with a group, the adjoining teacher will need to stand in between the bubbles to supervise.

During break times a first aider will always be on duty.

PPE and First aid resources continue to remain at the bottom of the steps leading to Year 2.

First Aid should be administered by the staff on break / lunch duty and children should only be sent to the school office by exception and where absolutely necessary to avoid children in different bubbles mixing.

Step 1	Teacher to put on gloves, mask, apron and glasses as appropriate (see protocol 9)
Step 2	Administer first aid as necessary
Step 3	Used PPE to be put in lidded bin
Step 4	Disinfectant wipes used on chair

Step 5	First aider advises office of the incident and office will add to the first aid log and either email or ring the parent to inform them of the accident depending on the nature of the accident.
Step 6	If a more serious incident- office to be informed via phone (all staff carry mobiles at all times but keep out of sight) and office staff phone home once information gathered
Step 7	Child to sit outside the office maintaining a social distance but appropriately supervised
Step 8	Child to be taken to the gate when parent arrives
