- Class teachers to closely monitor progress of PP in R/W/M & discuss at pupil progress mtgs / strategy mtgs
- Booster intervention groups to take place
- Third Space learning for all PP children who are in Y3 AND ABOVE who need the gap closing
- National tutoring partnership tutor teaching disadvantaged children in groups of 3
