



## Information Technology Vocabulary Information Information technology (IT) is technology the use of computers to store, save and communicate information computer Two or more computers that networks are connected with one another The internet is a huge internet network of computers all connected together The world wide web ('www' **World Wide** or 'web' for short) is a Web collection of webpages found on lots of computers Taking part in exchanging communication information, ideas and feelings The action of working collaboration together with someone to produce something. online Online information is found, information on the internet, viewed and understood. Someone's right to keep their privacy personal matters and relationships secret To keep all the information security stored on a computer or on the internet safe copyright Copyright is a legal protection extended to those who produce creative works ownership Something that belongs to vou
